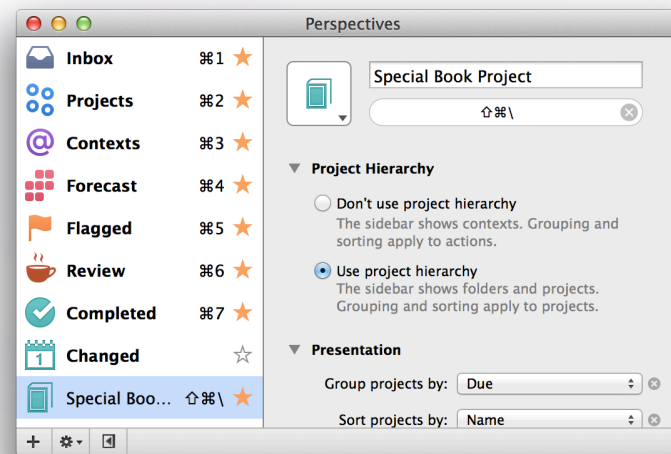

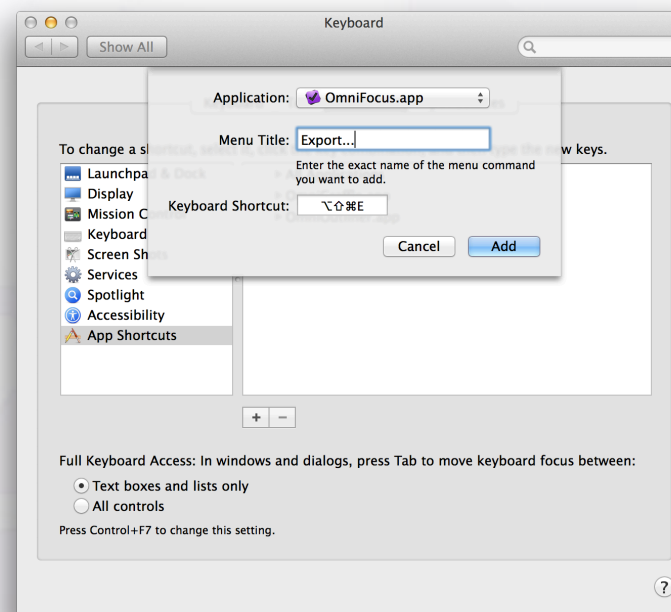
If you have upgraded to OmniFocus 2 Pro, choosing **Perspectives** ▶ **Show Perspectives** (⌘ ⌘ P) opens a special window in which you can create and configure new Perspectives. To add a new Perspective, click the Add button (+) at the lower-left corner of the Perspectives window, and then configure its properties, including the perspective's name, keyboard shortcut, and icon, just to name a few.



Creating Custom Keyboard Shortcuts

Not every menu item in OmniFocus 2 has its own keyboard shortcut. However, you can create custom keyboard shortcuts in **System Preferences** ▶ **Keyboard** ▶ **Shortcuts**.

Choose **App Shortcuts** in the left sidebar, and then select **OmniFocus.app** from the **Application** popup menu. Next, enter the exact title of the menu item you'd like to assign a keyboard shortcut to (for example, **Export...**), set a keyboard shortcut by pressing the keys you'd like to use (for example, ⌘ ⌘ E to Export tasks with OmniFocus 2 Pro), and then click Add to save and add the shortcut to OmniFocus.



Outlining Shortcuts

To set your mode for outlining, choose **OmniFocus** ▶ **Preferences** ▶ **General**, and look to the Outlining section.
